To be promoted to O-7, an officer must first complete a full tour in a Joint-Duty-Assignment—an assignment to a unit that comprises members from two or more of the services. This requirement can be waived, in some instances. The mandatory retirement age for all general officers is 62.

In the military, officers are expected to behave like ladies and gentlemen. Conduct unbecoming is an Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ) rule that is easily added as a second offense if the officer, cadet, or midshipman is convicted of a more harsh crime like larceny, underage drinking, or getting arrested for a bar fight (assault).
