The Gates-MacGinitie Reading Test is designed to assess student reading levels throughout the course of their education. Aligned with state and national reading standards (Common Core Standards), these exams were created to determine overall reading ability, specifically in the areas of decoding, phonemic awareness, phonics, vocabulary, and comprehension.

What is the Gates-MacGinitie Reading Test?

The Gates-MacGinitie Reading Tests allow teachers to track a student's reading achievements and challenges over the course of her school career. The tests are also normed against national standards, so teachers can determine where individual students, or a group of students, stand in relation to children at the same grade level across the country.

Explanation of the Gates-MacGinitie Reading Test ...

The Gates-MacGinitie Reading Test is a multiple-choice test. The timed tests for younger readers last between 75 and 100 minutes, while those in third grade and beyond only get 55 minutes. The text examines five language and reading abilities, including literary concepts, oral language concepts, letter recognition and letter-sound relationships.

To score at or above Grade 8, the score is 78; at or above Grade 9, 81.5; and at or above Grade 11, 88. No students scored at Grade 10, 12 and PHS. The correlation coefficient of 0.801 between the AST and the GMRT indicates (.801) or 64.16% common variance.
