It is a manual procedure that is recommended by national guidelines for breech presentation of a pregnancy with a single baby, in order to enable vaginal delivery. It is usually performed late in pregnancy, that is, after 36 gestational weeks, but preferably 37 weeks, and can even be performed in early labour.

ECV has about a 58 percent success rate in turning breech babies (and a 90 percent success rate if the baby is in a transverse lie.) But sometimes a baby refuses to budge or rotates back into a breech position after a successful version. ECV is more likely to work if this isn't your first baby. Not all women can have ECV.

Breech position and what it means for labor and delivery ...

Breech presentation refers to a fetal position which is not optimal for vaginal delivery. This is diagnosed usually around the 32nd or 34th week of pregnancy. It is most often followed with an appointment for what is called a 'manual version', when the doctor maneuvers the baby into a more optimal position with their hands through your belly.
