Multivariate Logistic Regression As in univariate logistic regression, let $\pi(x)$ represent the probability of an event that depends on p covariates or independent variables. Then, using an inv.logit formulation for modeling the probability, we have: $\pi(x) = \frac{e^{\beta_0 + \beta_1 x_1 + \dots + \beta_p x_p}}{1 + e^{\beta_0 + \beta_1 x_1 + \dots + \beta_p x_p}}$
