## **Current status of food-borne trematode infections**

Many of the trematode infections, such as schistosomiasis, clonorchiasis, and pulmonary paragonimiasis, can be fatal if left untreated. Infection with intestinal trematodes is rarely fatal. No racial predisposition to trematode infections is apparent. Most trematode infections have no sexual predisposition.
